# Highlights 2010

- Dwelling register is almost completed
- Quality improvement activities for addresses continue
- "Blue Light Authorities" user group is formed
- The new technical environment (Elips program) is to be introduced for buildings, addresses and dwellings
- A National Geodata Strategy is formed



# The Dwelling Register

1. The Dwelling Register will be established for all of Sweden's 290 municipalities during the autumn of 2010
2. Connecting people to dwellings start in September 2010

# Goals for the main quality improvement activities for Addresses

- Coordinates on all addresses
- All addresses should have connections to cadastral parcels

But - in some cases the addresses will be migrated without following proper standards

- The new Standard for Addresses is now supported by a handbook with examples
- A national tour arranged by SIS (Swedish Standards Institute) will inform on the Standard on 10 places from June till October





# User group for Blue Light Authorities

- One of four user groups
- The aim is to improve the possibilities to find a place quickly with the help of whatever information the caller can give – address, square, statue, restaurang, point of interest



# The change program (Elips)

- Buildings, addresses and dwellings will be migrated into the new technical environment in December 2010
- The webbased updating system of today - BALK – is replaced by a new - LINA
- From the end of 2011 it will be possible for a municipality to update the information without using LINA
- Geographical and text based information will be integrated in a single object
- A pilot version of a web service for addresses will be released in June

# The National Geodata Strategy

- A strategy for the overall provision of geodata in the country
- A Geodata Project, led by Lantmäteriet, has developed two models:
  - a collaboration model
  - a business model
- A Geodata portal has been launched
- The INSPIRE directive will be incorporated into Swedish law from 1st of Januar, 2011

## Enklare att få tillgång till kartor och geografisk miljöinformation

Nu ska det bli enklare att följa förändringar i miljön, för att förutse, förebygga och hantera naturolyckor och för att effektivt kunna utforma och genomföra EU:s miljöpolitik. Det är innebörden i regeringens proposition 2009/10: 224 "Ett sammanhängande system för geografisk miljöinformation".

Regeringens förslag till lag ska säkerställa tillgången till geografisk miljöinformation nationellt och inom Europa. Kartor och annan geografisk information ska vara tillgänglig via elektroniska tjänster på Internet dygnet runt.
